



- Edison holds E&P licences in Egypt, Norway, Croatia, Algeria, Israel, UK and Falkland Islands
- Egypt is a key country with Abu Qir, Rosetta and West Wadi El Rayan fields.
- Most of Edison production comes from assets within the Mediterranean Basin where operations started at the end of '80
- Available supply of natural gas: 15.8 bcm/year
- Hydrocarbon reserves of 361 million barrels oil equivalent
- 1 offshore regasification terminal with a total capacity of 8 bcm/year in the Northern Adriatic Sea
- 3 storage fields
